Call to Order/Roll Call

Mayor Marty Rahl called the Special Board Meeting to order at 1:15 p.m. at the Town Hall at 2067 Main Street in Rye, Colorado. Those in attendance were as follows: Marty Rahl, Mayor; Sheila Henderson, Mayor Protem; Kathy Dufty, Trustee; and Jocelyn Mower, Clerk. Regular Meeting

Jocelyn Mower reviewed the updated vendor spreadsheet and the donation spreadsheet for the Town Square Fair event being held on August 6, 2022. The town has received enough donations to cover all expenses for the event. The board discussed the expenses for water and sewer education and determined that those expenses will not be included in the needed donations spreadsheet. Jocelyn Mower then reviewed all of the donated gift cards for the drawing that will be held at Town Hall during the event. The board agreed that a total of \$500 worth of visa gift cards will be purchased for the drawing. Jocelyn Mower then reviewed the Town Square Fair Map and the associated assigned spaces spreadsheet. Sheila Henderson stated that she will reach out to a former officer to see if he can attend the event.
